SHOW LENGTH: 45 mins, with an optional 10 min Q&A or 'meet and greet' after.

STAGE REQUIREMENTS: Minimum 4 x 4 m space, where we can make noise, with access to power.

AGE APPROPRIATENESS: An Utterly Rubbish Adventure was written for Kindergarten–Year 2, and is also suitable for Years 2+ for students studying Drama.

CURRICULUM LINKS: Arts, English, Drama, Music, Visual Arts, Science, Design & Technologies, Literacy, Critical & Creative Thinking, Ethical Understanding, Sustainability.

PERFORMANCE COST: \$6 per student (with a minimum fee of \$350).
